

## Boone Hang2

### Tech Spec's

---

- Side-loading design makes mounting the most cumbersome racks a snap.
- Quickly mounts to any available wall space.
- Maximize storage in small spaces.
- Provides attachment points for 2 racks, carriers or draw bars.
- 90 lb. load capacity
- Models available for 2" and 1 ¼" hitches. Fits racks with shoulder pins (i.e. Saris, Yakima and Thule)
- Constructed of tough, powder coated carbon steel
- 4" tall and extends 5" from the wall
- Weighs 1 lb.
- Mounting hardware included.

### Use and Mounting Tips

Before mounting your Hang2 take into consideration what gear will be stored on the unit and how often it will be used.

Hitch-mounted gear is easily attached to the Hang2 by slipping the hole for the hitch pin onto the rear Locating Pin and allowing the square tube of the gear to rest on top of front Locating Pin. Secure your gear to the Hang2 by inserting a Bridge Pin into the through hole in the rear Locating Pin. NOTE: If wall clearance is a problem reverse the above sequence by slipping the hitch pin hole onto the front Locating Pin and allowing the square tube of the gear to rest *underneath* the rear Locating Pin. This will give an additional 2" of wall clearance.

- Bike Racks
  - If storing multiple pieces of gear, determine the location for the bike rack first.
  - Bike racks can either be stored right side up (as it attaches to your hitch receiver), or upside down.
- Tailgate Tables and other Racks
  - Store either right side up (as it attaches to your hitch receiver), or upside down.

- Check the amount of horizontal space needed. Typically, this will be about 5' (2 1/2' each side of Hang2). Make sure to leave room for easy maneuverability.
- Cargo carriers
  - Store in a vertical position. Simply hang the carrier from the front Locating Pin.
  - Check floor to carrier clearance before mounting.

- Draw bars
  - Store either in a horizontal or vertical position (simply hanging from the front Locating Pin).
